

TEMPLATE 2: INVITATION TO YOUNG PEOPLE (AND THEIR PARENTS)

Here is an invitation for a focus group with young people. Keep short, engaging, fun and to the point.

We want to know what makes this [club/facility/etc..] special. Come and tell us what you think.

What will be asked?

- There are no 'right or wrong answers' we just want your/your child's views about.

- Yes, the research is private and confidential to the group being interviewed.
- We will write about what is said so it does <u>not</u> identify you/your child unless you (their parent/guardian) agree.
